

Investment on infrastructure construction in Xinjiang this year may reach to more than one trillion

The Silk Road Economic Belt international Seminar was held in Urumqi on June 26. Mr. Zhang Chunxian, Party Secretary of CPC Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Regional Committee, said that Xinjiang as bridgehead of China's opening up to the west is crucially positioned to have important roles to play on the Silk Road Economic Belt. He also remarked that since the Central CPC Committee held the 2nd Xinjiang Working conference late May, Xinjiang is focusing on the building of "Five centers, three bases and one corridor". Five centers are regional transport hub, regional center of commerce, trade and logistics, regional financial center, regional cultural and education center and regional health and medical center. Three bases and one corridor means based on the energy and resources advantages of Xinjiang, we will quicken the building of national base for large-scale oil and gas production and storage, the base for coal production, thermal power generation and coal chemical industry, and wind power generation base, and national energy and resources corridor in Xinjiang.

In mid June, vice chairman of Xinjiang Mr. Shi Dagang disclosed to the media that investment on infrastructure construction in Xinjiang this year is expected to reach to RMB 800 billion, and may even break through one trillion.
